



## NOTES

### 1. Assessment Grades

Grades are awarded by the University Senate on the advice of the Summer School Examination Board which takes into account any factors relevant to the student's academic performance (e.g. medical). The result of formal assessment is indicated by a numerical mark, 40 representing the pass mark.

### 2. Interpretation of Sussex's grading system

Summer School courses carry 15 credits each. Since the standard annual load for a Sussex student is 120 credits, each course is equivalent to four semester hours or 7.5 ECTS credits.

The table below is provided to assist with the comparison of Sussex's grades with the grading system in your country. The table shows the relationship between Sussex grades and the undergraduate degree classification. For students from North America, in addition to the definitive Sussex grade, a North American letter grade (derived under BUTEX guidelines) is also provided for advisory purposes. This may have been modified in the light of circumstances known to the Summer School Examination Board.
